

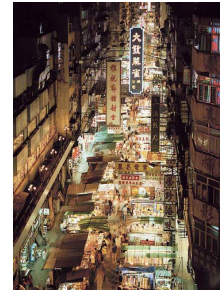
## City of Lights and Countdown Cruise with Chinese Seafood Dinner

18:00 Pick-up at a hotel in downtown Kowloon (exact location to be confirmed).



18:30 A scenic drive on the expressway and the Lantau link. A stop at the viewing platform before crossing the world's longest road and rail suspension bridge. The graceful 2.2 kilometre Tsing Ma Bridge is one of the landmarks of Hong Kong. The Lantau Link View Point, north of the bridge of Tsing Yi provides excellent views of this and two adjoining bridges.

19:00 Drive to next stop - the open air night market "Temple Street" which offers an amazing range of inexpensive items: bags, accessories, and inexpensive clothing and children toys. There are also fortune-tellers and impromptu Chinese opera performances.



20:15 Drive to Lei-Yue-Mun fishing village for dinner. Lei-Yue-Mun fishing village, situated at Hong Kong's Eastern harbour and still carrying on many Chinese heritage, is widely known to the gourmets as a seafood paradise. Here visitors are attracted to many traditional scenes, like people making choice from a variety of seafood fresh from fishmongers' stalls and tanks.

20:45 Seafood dinner (set menu) at Hyde Park Garden Restaurant

22:30 After dinner, pick-up by our Chinese Junk "Oriental Dragon" from Lei-Yue-Mun fishing village for one-hour Victoria Harbour Countdown cruise. Victoria Harbour is one of the world's busiest and most impressive natural harbours. Hong Kong's striking coastline and the countless container vessels, junks, sampans and pleasure craft gliding around the harbour create an exciting view.



23:59 Countdown (with a glass of champagne served on board)

At the stroke of midnight, a show will features an eight-minute display of pyrotechnics on various buildings, with Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Center as the focal point (the venue for this show is subject to change and final sponsorship). In addition, pyrotechnics will be launched on Victoria Harbour to enrich the visual experience and showcase Hong Kong's spectacular appeal.

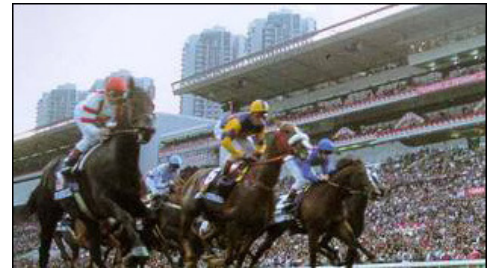


### Day 04 – 21 February, 2015 (Saturday)
