- Visitors are required to book and pay for the registration fees of the tours online or at Hong Kong Tourism Board (HKTB) Kowloon Visitor Centre. Booking is available on a first-come-first-served basis.
- No refund except for tour cancellation due to bad weather. Refund will be done via online payment system, except those payments had been made in HKTB Kowloon Visitor Centre. Participants who registered in HKTB Kowloon Visitor Centre, please bring along the original official receipt to HKTB Visitor Centre to arrange refund.
- The programme host and HKTB may refuse participation to any person who in their sole discretion is unfit for the programme, change the route, terminate or shorten the trip due to weather or other exigencies. In case of dispute, the decision of HKTB shall be final.
- All participants should wear proper outdoor clothing, and bring along their own packed lunch and adequate water, personal equipment and gear for different weather conditions. Bike, helmet and gloves will be provided for cycling tour on set off and shall be returned in good condition at tour end.
- Tours will be cancelled if Typhoon Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or higher, or any rainstorm warning signal is issued by the Hong Kong Observatory two hours before the assembly time on the day of the tour.
