Visits to attractions such as Huangpu Old Port and Ancestral Temple. Huangpu egg omelette for lunch and Guangdong cuisine for dinner

DAY ⑤ Shunde + Zhongshan

Visits to the Bruce Lee Ancestral Hall and Italina Jewellery DIY Zone. Jun'an steamed pork for lunch and Shi Qi roasted pigeon for dinner

DAY ⑥ Zhuhai + Macau

Visits to major attractions in Zhuhai and Macau, including Meixi Torii, A-Ma Temple, and Red Market. Seafood hot pot for lunch and Portuguese cuisine for dinner
