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ICBC (Asia) e-Sports & Music Festival Hong Kong – SMTOWN SPECIAL STAGE in HONG KONG All tickets are sold out

Organised by the Hong Kong Tourism Board (HKTB), “ICBC (Asia) e-Sports & Music Festival Hong Kong” will be staged at the Hong Kong Coliseum from 4 to 6 August. One of the biggest highlights of the festival will be SMTOWN SPECIAL STAGE in HONG KONG, which will be held on 5 August (Saturday). The tickets were on sale again on Monday this week and are sold out today.

Mr Anthony Lau, Executive Director of the HKTB, said, “It is very encouraging that the tickets are sold out on the third day of the reopening of ticket sales. We would like to express our heartfelt gratitude for the enthusiastic support of the fans and believe that the exciting series of activities at “ICBC (Asia) e-Sports & Music Festival Hong Kong” will certainly offer visitors and local residents an unforgettable summer experience.” Mr Lau added that best seats were reserved for ticket holders who had booked in advance to let them enjoy the exciting performances by Korea’s hottest stars and groups at the indoor venue.

Arrangements for Collection of New Venue Admission Tickets or Refunds

Effective from 17 July 2017 (12:00 noon) to 5 August 2017 (7:00pm), ticket holders of Pre-sold Tickets can collect the new admission ticket for “SMTOWN SPECIAL STAGE in HONG KONG” at the Hong Kong Coliseum by the following ways.

Collection of the New Venue Admission Ticket

- Ticket holders of Pre-sold Tickets purchased through Hong Kong Ticketing by credit card:
The cardholder must collect the New Venue Admission Ticket in Person by presenting the same credit card used for the purchase of the Pre-sold Ticket at Hong Kong Ticketing Box Offices / Tom Lee Outlets within the above period. The cardholder’s signature on the acknowledgement receipt is required when collecting the ticket.

- Ticket holders of Pre-sold Tickets purchased through Hong Kong Ticketing by cash:
Ticket holders must present the Pre-sold Tickets at the Hong Kong Ticketing box office at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre to redeem the New Venue Admission Ticket.

The New Venue Admission Ticket cannot be cancelled, exchanged and refunded once collected. Lost or damaged New Venue Admission Tickets will not be replaced. Please keep your ticket secure.

Refund Arrangement

If ticket holders would like to process refund, please do not collect New Venue Admission Tickets. Ticket holders (both cash & credit card) must present the Pre-sold Tickets to proceed with the refund application at the Hong Kong Ticketing Box Office at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre during the above period. EXO has been one of the best-selling Korean groups since their debut, with their three albums having sold over a million copies each. They have received the highest awards in various music award presentation ceremonies for four successive years. They are so popular around the globe that tickets for their world tours always sell out fast.



Red Velvet

Red Velvet is a five-member girl group which debuted with their single "Happiness" in 2014. Songs released subsequently, such as "Ice Cream Cake", "Russian Roulette" and "Rookie", have achieved great success. Their popularity has soared as a result, and they have gained global attention since then.



NCT

NCT's name stands for Neo Culture Technology, describing the group's "openness" and "flexible" size. The group may include new members at any time, and there is no limit to the number. They are currently the group with the most potential. Debuting in 2016, subgroup NCT 127 focuses on the K-POP music market, while NCT DREAM is a dynamic and vibrant subgroup formed mainly by teens.



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
