


Temporary Road Closure Arrangement in Phases for the Avenue of Stars

In the light of special event, Avenue of Stars will be temporarily closed in phases from 00:00 am on 23 November 2023 (Thursday) to 12:00 noon on 3 December 2023 (Sunday) for preparations.

Partial Road Closure



The Avenue of Stars will be partially closed from:

- 1. 00:00 am on 23 November 2023 (Thursday) to 18:00 pm on 29 November 2023 (Wednesday)
- 2. from 8:00 am on 1 December 2023 (Friday) to 12:00 noon on 3 December 2023 (Sunday).



Full Road Closure



The Avenue of Stars will be fully closed from 18:00 pm on 29 November 2023 (Wednesday) to 8:00 am on 1 December 2023 (Friday). Please follow the staff's instructions to take a detour to your destination.

We highly recommend residents and tourists to avoid going to the Avenue of Stars when the abovementioned road closure measures are in effect and use Salisbury Road to go to other destinations to avoid delaying your itinerary.
