

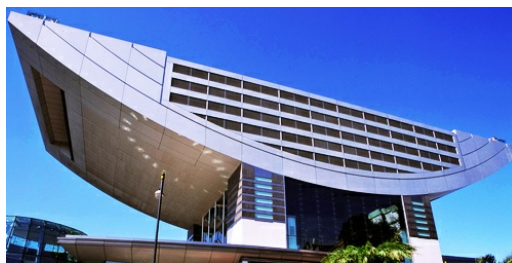


Hong Kong Summer Fun: My Time to 'Play'...
