## **Q** Tour Highlights


- Discover fascinating old Hong Kong stories at lively Temple Street and the century-old Yau Ma Tei Wholesale Fruit Market

- 4. Dinner in a local "ice café", or at a street side dai pai dong food store

- 6. Stroll around Temple Street Night Market, the heart of Kowloon
- 7. Enjoy popular Hong Kong street snacks or desserts
