P Tour Itinerary

- 1. Start at the century-old **Western Market**. Stroll around the district to follow the footsteps of Tony Leung in "Infernal Affairs"
- Wander down Hollywood Road, the romantic backdrop of Anita Mui and Leslie Cheung in "Rouge"
- 3. Uphill next to **Man Mo Temple**, glimpse old Hong Kong from "The World of Suzie Wong"
- 4. Stroll along Tai Ping Shan Street, listen to stories of Louis Koo and Daniel Wu on the set of "Don't Go Breaking My Heart"
- 5. Pass by Bridges Street where Andy Lau shot an action sequence in "Running on Karma", proceed to U Lam Terrace and Wing Lee Street where memorable scenes from movies including "Echoes of the Rainbow" were shot; compare old and new Sheung Wan
- 6. Stop at **PMQ** to recap "Three: Going Home". Tour ends at **Kau U Fong**, the dai pai dong where Sean Lau ate hotpot with Bowie Wu in "Overheard 2"
