Transfer to Macau by coach. Visit the Ruins of St. Paul's, Mount Fortress, Section of Old City Walls, Na Tcha Temple and a souvenir shop. Overnight in Macau

DAY 6 Macau to Hong Kong to India (breakfast)

Free time till coach to the pier. Direct ferry to Hong Kong International Airport for return flight
