#### DAY (1)

Visit the Hong Kong Museum of History and the Hong Kong Science Museum

### DAY (2)

Explore Hong Kong's development at the Urban Renewal Exploration Centre or Heritage of Mei Ho House museum and visit a service organisation for the elderly or mentally disabled

See Hong Kong's wildlife at Mai Po Nature Reserve, led by a World Wildlife Fund expert

#### DAY (4)

Join a guided tour at the Legislative Council Complex and the North Kowloon Magistracy building. Visit Tai O fishing village with a lesson in making salted eggs or fishing nets

#### **DAY** (5)

Take the intercity through train to Shenzhen, visit Dapeng Fortress and Daya Bay Nuclear Power Plant

#### DAY (6)

Go to Yantian to "Dive for Love" and learn about coral conservation in the shared waters of Hong Kong and Shenzhen
