Q Tour Highlights

- Visit the unique and unusual architecture of Lin Fa Temple, featuring its famous half-octagonal roof. During the Mid-Autumn Festival, the temple hosts fascinating Fire Dragon Dance shows
- Take a historical tram ride at Chun Yeung Street, which bisects the wet market. Immerse in a slice of local life
- Explore the huge building complex nicknamed "Monster Building" at Quarry Bay, where the Hollywood movie "Transformer 4" was shot
- Stop at Kowloon Walled City Park, the site of a once notorious criminal fortress that stood beyond the reach of the law

2. Visit **Lin Fa Temple** in Tai Hang
3. Take a tram ride through a wet market at **Chun Yeung Street** in North Point

5. Explore **Kowloon Walled City Park**
