Tour Highlights

- Visit the unique and unusual architecture of Lin Fa Temple, featuring its famous half-octagonal roof. Chun Yeung Street During the Mid-Autumn Festival, the temple hosts fascinating Fire Dragon Dance shows
- Take a historical tram ride at Chun Yeung Street, which bisects the wet market. Immerse in a slice of local life
- Explore the huge building complex nicknamed "Monster Building" at Quarry Bay, where the Hollywood movie "Transformer 4" was shot
- Stop at Kowloon Walled City Park, the site of a once notorious criminal fortress that stood beyond the reach of the law

- 2. Visit Lin Fa Temple in Tai Hang
- 3. Take a tram ride through a wet market at Chun Yeung Street in North Point
- 4. Visit the crowded residential building clusters "Monster Building" at Quarry Bay
- 5. Explore Kowloon Walled City Park
