2. Take a photo at **Choi Hung Estate** and visit old-fashioned stores
3. Search for the light well at **Ping Shek Estate**
4. Visit historical **Sam Shan Kwok Wong Temple**
5. Pass an old-style playground, discover the **calligraphy of the "King of Kowloon" and the statue of "Wing Chun Master" Ip Jun**
6. Explore the community bakery, photo developing store and grocery store, and taste traditional snacks
