

Nature in the City: Kowloon Park with Eco Experts



Take a leisurely stroll through a hidden natural oasis at the heart of bustling Tsim Sha Tsui. This tour is suitable for all ages to enjoy the largest green park on the Kowloon Peninsula – Kowloon Park. Led by experienced eco guides, learn about more than 35 species of Hong Kong flora and spot over 20 kinds of birdlife. Visitors also get to explore the former British Whitfield Barracks.
