

## Nature in the City: Explore Hong Kong Park



Originally Victoria Barracks, Hong Kong Park is a lush urban oasis that brings the tranquillity of nature to the heart of this thriving metropolis. The sound of running water throughout offers a serene counterpoint to the busy city, encouraging visitors to explore and relax.

2. Starting from the **Fountain Plaza** and **Artificial Lake**, walk to the **Tai Chi Garden**
3. Enjoy a guide walkthrough of the **Aviary**, followed by a stroll to **Vantage Point**
4. The tour ends with a visit to the **Conservatory** and **Flagstaff House Museum of Tea Ware**
