## **Q** Tour Highlights

- Engage with wildlife at a tropical rainforest-themed aviary that houses more than 80 species of birds
- Re-discover revitalised buildings like Flagstaff House, a former British commander office/residence, and Rawlinson House, which currently hosts park management offices



## **Tour Itinerary**

- 1. Gather at MTR Admiralty Station and proceed to Hong **Kong Park**
- 2. Starting from the Fountain Plaza and Artificial Lake, walk to the Tai Chi Garden
- 3. Enjoy a guide walkthrough of the Aviary, followed by a stroll to Vantage Point
- 4. The tour ends with a visit to the Conservatory and Flagstaff House Museum of Tea Ware
