Walk to St Luke's College, Nam Koo Terrace, Southorn Playground, J Residence, The Pawn, the Old Wan Chai Post Office and Old Wan Chai Market to hear horrifying stories. Stop at a papier-mâché shop during a visit to Hung Shing Temple. Savour local flavours at a *dai pai dong*.
