Early admission: Please arrive at the admission entrance of the Event <u>at least 30 minutes</u> prior to the start of the relevant session for admission and bag search procedures.

Event Rules and Regulations

In this document, the following definitions apply:

"Event" means the Harbour Chill Carnival – Music Shows in the Harbour

"Organiser" means the Hong Kong Tourism Board and its employees or its subcontractors

"Participant(s)" means an individual or group who attends the Event as a spectator or audience member

- "Ticket" a physical or electronic ticket with valid admission QR code for the Event in the form of an electronic ticket saved in 'My Wallet' on the Discover Hong Kong website, a printed ticket or a pdf
- "Venue" means the Audience Zone of the Event, i.e. Water Sports and Recreation Precinct, Wan Chai

Admission Guidelines

- 1. A valid QR code of each Ticket must be presented at the admission counter for verification by the Organiser. Each Ticket admits one person to the Venue.
- 2. All Participants and their belongings shall undergo bag search procedures before being admitted into the Venue.
- 3. Children aged 3 years or below are not allowed to enter the Venue. Children aged 12 or below must be accompanied by a parent or an adult guardian at all times during the Event.
- 4. All admission area allocations for the Event shall be at the Organiser's sole and absolute discretion. The view from some areas is partially obstructed.
- 5. A designated area at the Venue is reserved for wheelchair users and one accompanying minder per wheelchair user (with valid ticket only). Wheelchair users are required to register in advance with the Organiser by sending an email to <u>info@hktb.com</u> before each session of the music show to access this area.
- 6. No luggage storage service will be provided. Participants are advised to take care of their personal belongings.
- 7. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse admission by any latecomers to the Event or determine when and how latecomers will be admitted.

Rules for Entry and Re-entry

8. Each admission QR code can only be used once. For any re-entry within the same session, Participants must present their identification wristband provided at the first entry and go through the bag search procedures again.



9. Participants are required to exit the Venue after the first session and re-enter for the second session on the same date using valid QR codes. To enter the second session, a valid QR code from the Ticket must be presented at the admission counter. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in denial of entry to the second session of the same date.

Behaviour at the Event

- 10. Parking areas are not available. Please use public transport.
- 11. All Participants must:
 - (i) observe and comply with all notices issued by the Organiser concerning operational arrangements of the Event;
 - (ii) observe and comply with any laws of Hong Kong, including but not limited to, the National Flag and National Emblem Ordinance (Instrument A401), the Law of the People's Republic of China on Safeguarding National Security in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and other relevant laws of Hong Kong in relation to the safeguarding of national security ("National Security Law"); and
 - (iii) ensure that no act or activity which is likely to constitute or is likely to cause the occurrence of an offence endangering national security under the National Security Law or other laws of Hong Kong, or which would otherwise be contrary to the interests of national security, is engaged in the Event
- 12. The Organiser reserves the right to request that Participant leave the Venue at any point on reasonable grounds and take any appropriate action to enforce this right. By way of example, the Organiser may remove a participant who:
 - (i) has behaved in the Venue in a manner which, in the reasonable opinion of the Organiser, has or is likely to affect the enjoyment and/or safety of other participants (e.g. possessing any prohibited items or engaging in activities in the Venue set out below);



- (ii) uses threatening, abusive or insulting words or behaviour or in any way provokes or behaves in a manner which may provoke a breach of the peace;
- (iii) in the reasonable opinion of the Organiser, a Participant is under the influence of drugs or has consumed an excessive amount of alcohol; or
- (iv) in the reasonable opinion of the Organiser, a Participant has violated any notices issued by the Organiser, the National Security Law or other relevant laws of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.
- 13. Participants are prohibited from committing or attempting to commit any act in violation of the laws of the HKSAR and the National Security Law governing the HKSAR. Participants' act must not be contrary to the interest of national security. They must obey all lawful instructions given by the staff at the Event and the officers of relevant authorities, such as the Hong Kong Police Force and the Leisure and Cultural Services Department. Participants must leave the Venue immediately if requested to do so by event managers or security staff.
- 14. **Strictly forbidden**: Anyone who is found to have any prohibited items or who does not follow the house rules of the Venue will be refused entry to the Event:

Items prohibited in the Venue:

- (i) Dangerous or hazardous materials including but not limited to fireworks, smoke or gas canisters, explosives, etc.
- (ii) Weapons of any kind or objects that may give the appearance or impression of being weapons (e.g. toy guns)
- (iii) Any illegal drugs or substances
- (iv) Any glassware
- (v) Pets or other animals, except service animals (e.g. guide dogs)
- (vi) Amplifiers, lasers and laser pointers
- (vii) Large tripods, tents, folding chairs and stools



- (viii) Banners, flags or light boxes should not be hung or placed in a way that obstructs the view of other Participants. They should also not be placed in a way that could cause harm or injury to others. Offensive or inappropriate content is not allowed
- (ix) Other items that the Organiser determines may be harmful, disruptive, offensive or may impede the Event, or any associated facilities

Prohibited activities:

- (i) Setting up tents and/or bivvy sacks
- (ii) Smoking
- (iii) Littering and spitting
- (iv) Playing with kites or remote-controlled flying apparatus
- (v) Any recreational devices with wheels, including but not limited to bicycles, skateboards, scooters, inline skates, shoes with built-in wheels, etc.
- (vi) Photography, videotaping or recording with large-size apparatus or equipment that could obstruct the view or space of other Participants, regardless of the usage purpose
- (vii) Unauthorised photography, videotaping or recording of any kind except for personal use
- (viii) Selling goods or services, or the display of goods or services for sale at the entrance or in the Venue
- (ix) Distribution of unauthorised printed or recorded materials
- (x) Unauthorised events or display of any flag, banner, sign or wordings, or incitement of the crowd, and other unauthorised public gatherings
- (xi) Throwing or using any objects in the Venue to cause danger, unnecessary obstruction or interference with the programme, foul language or disorderly conduct
- (xii) Engaging in any unsafe act or other act that may impede the operation of the Venue or any associated facilities
- (xiii) Stage diving, moshing, climbing, crowd surfing
- (xiv) Standing and/or dancing in the passageways, sidewalks, stairways, promenade, or activities that cause danger, obstructions or disturbance to other Participants

Personal safety:

- (i) Take care of accompanying children or elderly or someone in need.
- (ii) Look after personal property.

- (iii) Respect the rights of other Participants at all times.
- (iv) Refrain from pushing, running, boisterous behaviour and queue-jumping.
- (v) Observe all reasonable instructions of the Organiser, security staff, officials and the Police.
- (vi) In case of emergency, please remain calm and comply with the announcement, instruction or request from the Organiser.
- 15. Participants are advised to bring a raincoat or other rain gear, and to avoid bringing a long umbrella.
- 16. Please follow instructions and routes provided by the Organiser when leaving the Venue.

General Terms and Conditions

- 17. These Event Rules and Regulations are subject to change without prior notice.
- 18. The Tickets are not transferrable or redeemable for cash. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel any Ticket which it reasonably suspects to have been made, obtained or downloaded in breach of these Event Rules and Regulations without any notice to that Participant.
- 19. The Organiser will not issue replacement Tickets and shall not be liable for any claim, loss, or damage incurred in relation to any Tickets being lost or damaged or stolen in any circumstances.
- 20. The Participant may be refused admission if any details on the Ticket have been omitted or altered or if the Ticket is damaged, defaced, or otherwise mutilated. The Organiser's decision on whether to refuse admission of the Participant is final and conclusive.
- 21. All admission area allocations for the standing music show shall be at the Organiser's sole and absolute discretion.

- 22. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse admission, at any time and at its absolute discretion, to any Participant or any person already admitted who fails to comply with the Event Rules and Regulations (which can be found on the Event's website) or to remove any person whose conduct is disorderly or unbecoming from the Venue, without any compensation.
- 23. During the Event, Participants faces may be captured and recorded by cameras for promotional and archival purposes without prior notice. By attending this Event, you hereby consent to the use of your image and likeness as captured during the Event.
- 24. During the Event, in case of any violation of these terms and conditions, illegal acts, fraud or abuse, the Organiser shall have the right to disqualify the relevant Participant(s) from admission to the Event without prior notice.
- 25. A Participant must comply with all relevant and applicable statutes, safety announcements and venue regulations whilst attending the Event. A Participant should assess whether he/she is suitable for attending the Event which may have special effects including, without limitation, sound, audio visual, pyrotechnic effects or lighting effects. The Organiser shall not be responsible for any discomfort or irritation caused by these special effects.
- 26. If the Event cannot be carried out or is interrupted due to orders from government authorities or agencies, serious cyberattacks, system failures, act of God, war, insurrection, riot, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, explosion, flood, theft of essential equipment, malicious damage, strike, lock out, weather, third-party injunction, national defence requirements, or other circumstances beyond the control of the Organiser, such circumstances will be regarded as force majeure. The Organiser shall not be liable for any damages, losses or disputes caused by force majeure.
- 27. The Organiser reserves the right to change, suspend or cancel the Event or amend its terms and conditions at its discretion without prior notice. The Organiser shall not be liable for any change, suspension or cancellation in relation to the Tickets or the Event.



- 28. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Organiser and its related personnel, management, employees and contractors shall not be responsible for any personal or property injury, loss or damage (including but not limited to any claims, injuries, costs or expenses) incurred or suffered by any person, Participant, as a result of their participation in the Event howsoever caused.
- 29. In case of any disputes, the decision of the Organiser shall be final and conclusive, and such decision shall be binding on all parties concerned.
- 30. These terms and conditions are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Hong Kong. Each party submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Hong Kong.
- 31. In the event of any discrepancy between the English and Chinese versions of this Event Rules and Regulations, the English version shall prevail.
- 32. The personal information and other related information of parties involved in the Event are subject to the applicable laws and regulations and the privacy policy of the Organiser. T 1	Standby Signal No. 1	The Event will continue as scheduled.
L 3	Strong Wind Signal No. 3	If the Hong Kong Observatory has issued the Strong Wind Signal No.3 within 3 hours before the Event commences, the Event will be <u>cancelled</u> .
が が 、 黄	Amber Rainstorm Warning Signal	If the Hong Kong Observatory issues the Amber or Red Rainstorm Warning Signal after the event commences, the Event
Red 和	Red Rainstorm Warning Signal	will be <u>suspended</u> or <u>cancelled</u> depending on the weather conditions.
ジババ Black 栗	Black Rainstorm Warning Signal	If the Hong Kong Observatory issues the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal after the event commences, the Event will be <u>cancelled</u> . Participants shall leave the Venue under safe conditions.

No. 8 Gale or Storm Signal or above Tropical Cyclone Warning Signals If the Hong Kong Observatory has issued the No.8 Gale or Storm Signal or above Tropical Cyclone Warning Signals within 3 hours before the Event commences, the Event will be <u>cancelled</u>.
