Hong Kong Tourism Board Announces Departure of Anthony Lau as Executive Director

The Hong Kong Tourism Board (HKTB) today announces that Mr Anthony Lau will leave the position of Executive Director upon completion of his current contract on 31 July 2019.

HKTB Chairman Dr Pang Yiu-Kai said, “We are saddened to see Anthony’s departure but we must respect his decision. On behalf of the HKTB, I would like to express our heartfelt gratitude to Anthony for his tireless efforts in promoting Hong Kong as one of the world’s leading travel destinations, and his tremendous contribution to the tourism industry of Hong Kong.”

Mr Lau joined the HKTB in 2007 and has been responsible for the organisation’s strategic direction over the past 12 years, keeping it decisively ahead of tourism trends through a series of innovative strategies and campaigns, and strengthening the HKTB’s partnerships with wide spectrum of stakeholders. Under his leadership, despite numerous challenges, the HKTB has created new business opportunities for the travel industry through continuous close cooperation with the Government, trade partners and regional tourism organisations.

A global search will begin shortly to identify a successor to lead the HKTB to new levels of excellence. Mr Lau will continue to oversee all aspects of the HKTB’s operation until his departure.
